Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA) Annual Report for 2021

The Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA) of September 4, 2003 (Public Law 108-79) was enacted by Congress to address the problem of sexual abuse of persons who are in custody within a state, federal or local confinement facility. Adherence to PREA standards supports the elimination, reduction and prevention of sexual abuse/sexual assault within our prisons, community corrections centers and local jails.

Turning Point of Central California has adopted a zero-tolerance policy regarding sexual abuse and sexual harassment. The agency is continuously improving operations to prevent, detect, and respond to sexual victimization. This annual report serves as compliance with PREA Community Confinement Facility Standards 115.287, 115.288 and 115.289.

Turning Point of Central California, Inc. ensures that allegations of sexual abuse or sexual harassment are referred for investigation to the appropriate agency with the legal authority to conduct criminal investigations, unless the allegation does not involve potentially criminal behavior in which case, the allegation is referred for administrative investigation. All allegations are referred for investigation.

Turning Point of Central California, Inc. will fully assist and support the appropriate agency conducting criminal investigations as requested. Residents of a Turning Point federal residential program are encouraged to immediately report allegations of sexually abusive behavior to a staff member they trust, the Director, or via the Resident Kiosk process. All allegations, including third-party reports, are confidential and will be thoroughly investigated

Turning Point of Central California currently operates by contract two community confinement facilities Fresno Golden State Residential Reentry Center is a male/female 40 bed RRC for the Federal Bureau of Prisons. Fresno Golden State RRC began daily operation on August 1, 2021 and is currently seeking PREA CCF Certification. The second community confinement facility is Bakersfield Kennemer Center which is a 50 bed CDCR Male Community Reentry Program (MCRP). Bakersfield Kennemer Center is not PREA certified.

RRC is well equipped with a state of the art surveillance system consisting of 40 cameras in total placed in various strategic areas of the entire facility. This provides around the clock surveillance in all areas of the facility to exclude resident rooms. RRC also has a staffing plan with two staff (one male/one female) onsite 24/7, 365 days around the clock providing constant supervision.

Golden State Residential Reentry Center

For the reporting period August 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021 there were no reported incidents or allegations of sexual abuse or sexual harassment. Therefore, there is no data, findings, or corrective actions to report at this time. Data collected at the end of year 2022 will be compared to the year 2021 for findings, corrective actions and further improvement in day to day operations for safety and prevention of sexual abuse. 
RRC plans to begin the below projects over the next year
